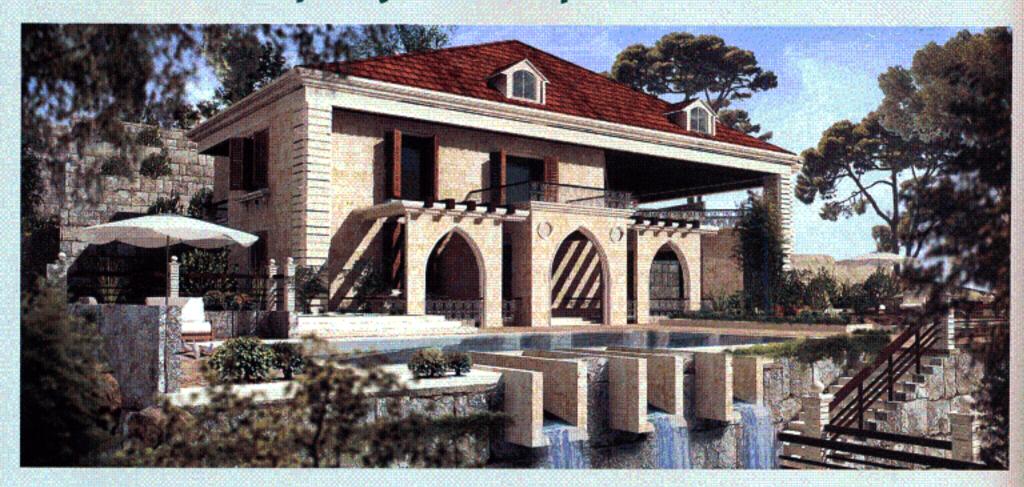

Morocco to build 129,000 low-cost housing units

Morocco will build 129,000 low-cost housing units whose price will not exceed USD 14,000, said Housing Minister, Ahmed Toufiq Hejira. The government's program includes the construction of 107,000 houses in the cities and 22,000 in the countryside, added the minister. So to help this plan succeed, the government

will provide real estate developers willing to join the programme with lands and many incentives.

Morocco has recently mobilised an overall land surface of 3,853 ha, in an effort to stimulate the property market and boost the sector in the country. It has also launched a prospective study to further develop the residential real estate sector by the year 2020.

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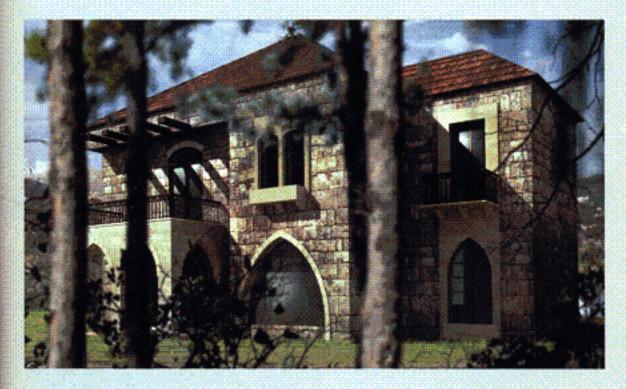
When was Dolmen established?

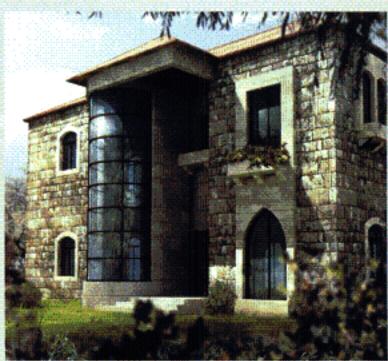

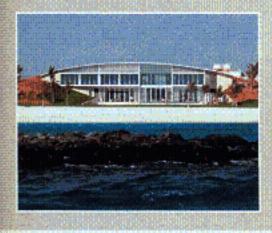
- Yarah Contracting: offers a complete range of construction services. It provides design concepts, construction operation and project management.

Zaya releases first completed Nurai Beachfront Estate for sale

Zaya, the UAE-based boutique real estate developer, announced the release of its first completed Beachfront Estate from its flagship project Nurai for sale, with a percentage of the proceeds being donated to two humanitarian organizations – the UAE Red Crescent, and Akshaya Patra.

The first Nurai home is one of the island's luxurious

Shoreline Beachfront Estates – with a built-up area of
approximately 12,960 sq ft (1,205 square meters), 6
bedrooms and 7 bathrooms, a double storey atrium, a
private beach and a private pool – offering an expansive
sense of space and spectacular views of the Arabian Gulf.

Dolmen landmark projects in Lebanon are:

-Jannat Falougha: 11 luxurious villas of 715 m2 to 1438 m2 of living area.

-Falougha Homes: 19 luxurious villas of 490 m2 to 550 m2 of living area.

The villas are spread over a scenic and terraced property offering each unit plenty of privacy, full unobstructed panoramic view and a massive garden for family recreation.

-Cedars Hills: A development project in Ain Zhalta consisting of 40 individually designed villas with living area ranging between 400 m2 and 1000 m2. Each villa enjoys a full unblocked panoramic view to the Barouk Cedars Reserve, the privacy of a large garden, an easy access to public gardens of 13, 000 m2, to kid's playgrounds and promenades. The project is fully allotted and offered as both ready built up villas as well as individual plots of 1300m2 to 3000m2 for development.

Who are your targeted customers? Investors or end users?

Our customers include both investors and end users depending on the type of the project. As I mentioned above, Dolmen develops projects either on lots that it directly owns and offers them directly to the end users, or develops projects to prominent investors.

What marketing tools are used to reach your customers?

Dolmen participates in exhibitions and conferences to directly reach potential customers and to build its business relationships. Dolmen marked an emphatic presence, through showcasing its three landmark projects in Cityscape Abu Dhabi 2009, following its earlier success at the Arabian World Construction Summit and Arab Economic Forum in Abu Dhabi, Lebanon and Qatar, in addition to Cityscape leddah KSA in June 2009.

Moreover, Dolmen will be one of the exhibitors in the highly visible event of and Cityscape Dubai in October 2009.

What's your assessment of the Lebanese Real Estate market?

The real estate in Lebanon has proven to be the most stable, durable and valuable investment in the Middle East. Prices of real estate have been rising consistently for the last ten years; even when property prices are falling in many Arab countries, Lebanese properties have been showing remarkable resilience with prices of 2009 reaching more than 30% rise over 2007 prices.

Are Arab Investors still active in the Lebanese real estate market?

Following the increasing number of tourists from the Arab countries, investment capital has made its way into Lebanon and property demand has hence increased significantly. Gulf nationals have also taken a great interest in investing in Lebanese properties following the world economic crisis that has affected the real state sector in the gulf area and diverged some of their capitals to Lebanon.

What are you future plans?

Besides the residential villas, Dolmen is currently working on developing a world class car racetrack in Falougha village at 1400m above sea level; a feat unmatched in the world. Additionally, in Souk El-Ghareb, Dolmen will develop a private hotel for a prominent Qatari individual. This hotel will be based on a new concept design providing a unique experience with the highest records of quality, ratability and customer satisfaction. In the heart of Beirut, Dolmen is developing a multipurpose tower consisting of 26 floors providing residential suites and offices. Moreover, Dolmen has newly established a branch in Doha - Qatar to start its developing projects in the Gulf region and the Arab World.
